The Really Really Free Market (RRFM) movement is a horizontally-organized collective of individuals who hosts temporary market sessions based on the gift economy. It challenges how we assign value to objects and services by emphasizing the importance of community and caring for one another through the act of sharing resources and knowledge.

Post-Museum started the Singapore chapter of RRFM in 2009, and having been active for more than 10 years, it is currently one of the longest running RRFMs in the world. Singapore Really Really Free Market (SRRFM) hosts a market session every two months, with hundreds of participants each time. Post-Museum has also started chapters of RRFM in various cities in Indonesia, Japan, Thailand, and the UK.

Post-Museum X WAM is now starting a new Worcester chapter of RRFM, and we welcome Worcester residents to join us!

This is a market where goods and services are offered for free.
